Authors are allowed to submit only one paper to this special session. All submitted papers will be peer-reviewed according to a high-quality and fast referee process. Authors will be notified whether their paper is accepted for presentation at the special session no later than **May 19, 2025**. Special session presenters are expected to discuss the papers during the session. The conference organizers will make the assignment of discussants at a later date.

Papers must be in English and include a cover page with the following information:

- An abstract of up to 500 words, with JEL classification and no more than 5 keywords
- Authors' full name and affiliation
- Contact details for the corresponding author (e-mail)
